How Equipment Storage Services Works

1 Add Storage to Your Purchase Order

Storage is purchased as a separate line item and must be included prior to factory shipment.

2 Equipment Ships to the Trane Storage Facility

Equipment is delivered directly from the factory to a secure Trane storage location.

3 Trane Manages Your Equipment

During storage, Trane provides inspections, insurance coverage, secure storage, and ongoing coordination as needed.

4 Ready When Your Project Is

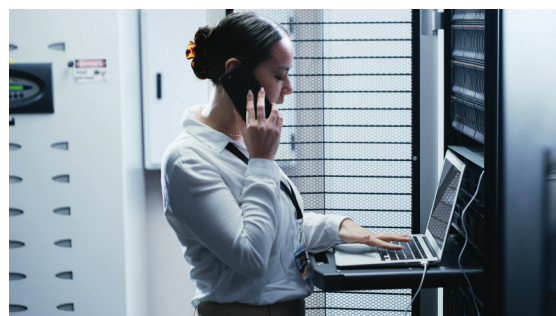
When your site is ready, Trane coordinates shipment from the storage facility to your final project destination. Trane requires notification of requested shipment 10 business days prior to departure from the storage facility. This allows time to secure transportation and any applicable permits to be issued.

Planning Considerations

- A purchase order for storage is required before equipment ships from the factory.
- Equipment entering storage requires the storage purchase order within two weeks of the customer-requested ship date unless an approved extension has been granted.
- The storage facility requires approximately 10 business days to coordinate shipment requests to the final project destination.
- Customers are responsible for transportation costs from the storage facility to the final jobsite unless previously placed into storage by Trane from advanced production.
