INSPECTION:

Check carefully for any shipping damage. This must be reported to and claims made against the transportation company immediately. Any missing parts should be reported to your supplier at once and replaced with authorized parts only.

INSTALLATION:

- 1. Disconnect power to the unit. Open the coil service door.
- 2. Attach the film to the inside lip of the top cover, using the magnetic strip. Check that you have a strong magnetic attraction between the strip and the top.
- 3. Center the film over the aluminum copper transition joints. (See figure 1.)
- 4. Cut any excess length of film to within 1/2 inch of the base.
- 5. Close coil service door and reconnect power to the unit.
